MAIN ACTIVITIES

- ✓ Monitor to identify those in need of international protection, advocate for alternatives to detention, and offer free legal counseling to individuals in Detention Centre for Foreigners and Temporary Reception Center for Migrants.
- ✓ Free legal aid and representation during Refugee Status Determination (RSD) procedures. Monitor and report on RSD quality, and assist authorities in fair and just adjudication of asylum claims, including legal opinions and Country of Origin Information research.
- ✓ Advocate for unhindered access to territory, improved reception conditions, and prioritize cases with specific needs.
- ✓ Provide training on National and International Refugee Law to key institutions, and capacity building to Border Police.
- ✓ Free legal aid and other support to individuals under international protection enabling their effective integration into society.
