The aim of the project funded by UNHCR is to identify, prevent and reduce the number of unregistered persons. Civil Rights Program Kosovo (CRPK) will provide legal aid primarily to internally displaced persons, voluntary returnees, persons with granted stateless status and vulnerable population groups.

- ✓ **LEGAL AID**
 Provision of legal assistance, counseling and in court representation to all people UNHCR works for and with.
- ✓ **MONITORING AND ADVOCACY**
 Monitor the implementation of the legislative framework, identify gaps and advocate for a change for benefit of unregistered people.
- ✓ **CAPACITY BUILDING**
 Enhancement of the international protection principles understanding associated with prevention of statelessness
- ✓ **COMMUNITY BASED PROTECTION**
 Regular communication and exchange of information with the affected communities on importance of birth registration and effective integration of persons with stateless status.
